

LANDLINE FEATURE TARIFF

Quick provides landline service by purchasing same from AT&T. Our features are priced at straight AT&T retail tariff rates. Our assumption has been that our customers prefer dealing with Quick and save money on toll calls. AT&T does not give us advance notice of changes in feature prices, so we monitor their bills to us and adjust our prices on the fly, as AT&T changes their rates. All Quick landline customers take Quick service without any term contract commitment because Quick currently has no assurance of its costs from one month to another.

You should know that we have been in litigation with AT&T since January, 2008 to force AT&T to comply with the terms of a mediation settlement agreement that they accepted in November 2007. In our view that settlement agreement obligates AT&T to allow Quick to obtain landline service at stable wholesale prices that would allow us to price features at least 20% below that of AT&T. However, it takes a long time to obtain a final and non-appealable court order. While we cannot save you money on features today, we expect a change from which you should benefit.
